GA-2023-91-RES-18

Subject: Application for observer status with the General Conference and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) – Conference of State Parties (COP)

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Vienna, Austria, from 28 November to 1 December 2023, at its 91st session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 41 of the Organization’s Constitution,

CONSIDERING the Cooperation Agreement signed between the United Nations and the International Criminal Police Organization – INTERPOL on 8 July 1997 to develop coordination in the field of crime prevention and administration of justice between the organs and bodies of the United Nations and INTERPOL,

RECALLING Resolution AG-2014-RES-03 on the INTERPOL response to emerging threats in environmental security,

CONVINCED of the need to further develop cooperation between INTERPOL and the United Nations in the area of crime prevention and criminal justice, specifically with respect to the prevention and suppression of environmental crime,

HAVING EXAMINED Report GA-2023-91-REP-17,

DEEMING that the application for observer status given at Appendix 1 to Report GA-2023-91-REP-17 is in conformity with the Organization’s interests and rules,

CONSIDERING that this application has been submitted on condition that the General Assembly approves it,

RECALLING Article 41 of the Constitution regarding relations with other organizations,

APPROVES General Assembly Report GA-2023-91-REP-17 and the application for observer status with the UNFCCC given at Appendix 1 of the said report.
