Subject: INTERPOL Vision 2030

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Vienna, Austria, from 28 November to 1 December 2023, at its 91st session:

RECALLING INTERPOL's *raison d'être* as an international criminal police organization, and recognizing the need for it to remain at the centre of global security architecture,

RECOGNIZING the importance of adapting to rapidly evolving socio-economic, geopolitical, technological, and environmental contexts, ensuring INTERPOL's continued relevance in the next decade,

REFERRING to the input received through comprehensive consultations undertaken with member countries and other stakeholders, leading to the consolidated strategic directions that reflect the collective requirements of the global law enforcement community,

HAVING CONSIDERED Report GA-2023-91-REP-15, submitted by the General Secretariat, which comprehensively presents the essence of the methodology, analysis, recommendations, procedures, and milestones of INTERPOL Vision 2030,

ENDORSES INTERPOL Vision 2030, including its analysis, insights, and action streams, as a framework to engage in a structured discussion on how INTERPOL can best leverage technology for the benefit of its member countries;

FURTHER ENDORSES the idea of creating an expert council, entitled the INTERPOL Future Council, to ensure that further development and implementation of INTERPOL Vision 2030 take into account the evolving needs of law enforcement in INTERPOL member countries;

TASKS the General Secretariat to develop the modalities of the INTERPOL Future Council and provide a progress update to the General Assembly at its 92nd session.
