Subject: Preparations for the establishment of an INTERPOL Liaison Office for the Caribbean located within CARICOM-IMPACS in St Michael, Barbados

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, from 18 to 21 November 2018 at its 87th session:

HAVING REGARD to Articles 8, 30 and 31 of the Organization's Constitution,

RECALLING the "Co-operation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization-INTERPOL and the Caribbean Community (CARICOM)", approved by the General Assembly at its 77th session (Resolution AG-2008-RES-15), and signed on 25 February and 19 March 2009,

CONSIDERING Recommendation No. 8 of the 22nd ICPO-INTERPOL Americas Regional Conference meeting in Willemstad, Curaçao, from 1 to 3 July 2013, "INTERPOL coordination with the Caribbean Community Implementation Agency for Crime and Security (CARICOM-IMPACS) to enhance the capacity of National Central Bureaus (NCBs) in the Caribbean",

HAVING EXAMINED Report GA-2018-87-REP-20 entitled "Preparations for the establishment of an INTERPOL Liaison Office for the Caribbean",

BEARING IN MIND the consultation process that was undertaken with CARICOM and with the relevant member countries through the adoption of the aforementioned recommendation,

CONVINCED of the interest of establishing this INTERPOL Liaison Office for the Caribbean within CARICOM-IMPACS's Joint Regional Communication Centre (JRCC) in St Michael, Barbados, to support police cooperation in the Caribbean,

ASKS the Secretary General to enter into discussions with the Government of Barbados with a view to finalizing a Draft Headquarters Agreement in compliance with the international standards for privileges and immunities of intergovernmental organizations;

DELEGATES to the Executive Committee the power to examine and approve the negotiated Draft Headquarters Agreement with the Government of Barbados and to authorize its signature.
