Subject: INTERPOL Policing Capability Enhancement Programme

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Santiago, Chile, from 15 to 18 October 2019 at its 88th session:

RECALLING INTERPOL's strategic objectives to continuously adapt its portfolio of services to meet member countries' evolving needs and to assist law enforcement globally with criminal intelligence exchange and analysis, in order to serve as the worldwide information hub for law enforcement cooperation,

ACKNOWLEDGING member countries' feedback on current policing capabilities and main policing services needed by NCBs and law enforcement agencies,

CONSIDERING that, based on the results of the cost-benefit analysis of all INTERPOL's policing capabilities, INTERPOL delivers greatest value to member countries when it focuses on the hosting and exchange of data, information and investigative leads,

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT INTERPOL's services of excellence, which should be used as flagship capabilities for enhancement priorities in order to maximize their value to member countries and increase INTERPOL's impact to frontline policing,

NOTING that the alignment of technology innovation opportunities with INTERPOL's services of excellence provides a basis for designing of INTERPOL's future policing capabilities architecture and innovation initiatives,

ENDORSES the enhanced global police-information hub function through increased sharing and enrichment of data and information;

TASKS the General Secretariat to implement the INTERPOL Policing Capability Enhancement Programme;

ALSO TASKS the General Secretariat to undertake fundraising activities to finance the INTERPOL Policing Capability Enhancement Programme;

URGES member countries to fund, promote and advocate the INTERPOL Policing Capability Enhancement Programme in order to allow its implementation.
